

College of Nursing and Health Sciences Registered Nurse to Bachelor of Science in Nursing (RN-to-BSN) Program Curriculum Progression

The five semester Nursing major sequence is offered every fall or spring depending on student demand. The sequence includes summer term. Cohorts may be offered online and/or in hybrid formats depending on the semester.

Additional courses (if needed) to meet graduation requirements, including General Education and Liberal Studies, may be completed before, during or after the five semesters of Nursing. Students will work with their advisor, after admission and transfer credit evaluation, to determine whether previous or transfer courses meet specific requirements and create a graduation plan. All degree requirements can be viewed and tracked on the Degree Audit Report available in eServices. Curriculum may be subject to change.

This Nursing curriculum is effective for students starting the Nursing major in Fall 2023.

The Fall 2023 cohort is being offered in an online format.

Students who started the major prior to Fall 2023 should refer to their degree audit in eServices or contact their advisor.
